Worship God's Son

Hebrews 1:1-9

Golden Text: He is the brightness of his glory, and the express image of his person, upholding all things by the word of his power

Lesson overview

The concept of worship is universal. Throughout the ages and throughout the world, mankind has felt compelled to bow down in worship to some deity or person. Sometimes this worship is motivated by fear, and sometimes by heartfelt appreciation. The Bible, however, warns us that all worship is empty and worthless unless it is directed toward the proper object and is accompanied by the proper attitude. Worship the Lord in the beauty of holiness (Psalms 29:2) Worship might make us feel good, but that is not its primary purpose. Worship is to be directed toward the Lord God alone, because he alone is worthy to be praised.

Highlight points of Lesson

- To understand that Jesus Christ, the Son of God, is God Himself and is superior to angels
- To give Jesus Christ the position of supremacy in all areas of our lives
- To worship Jesus Christ and live each day with a sense of his awesomeness
